### **Grapeview Community Watch Update.**

The GCA hosted their second Community Conversation on January 31<sup>st</sup>, which was open to all members of the community. As with our first Community Conversation with Sherriff Spurling in November of 2023, the focus this time was on safety and security in our neighborhood. Corporal Ripp shared his experiences and advice with our community members. Corporal Ripp also emphasized the importance of having an active and observant Neighborhood Watch program to deter crime and assist the Sherrif' department in their work. The event was well attended, and we offer our thanks to those who could make it.

A primary communication venue for the Grapeview Neighborhood Watch program is via our **Grapeview Neighborhood Watch page on Facebook**. *It is here that you will find more info that Corporal Ripp shared as well as other relevant posts*. This is a restricted group meant to include neighborhood members and to keep a focus on safety and security. As of Feb 12, 2024 we have over 230 members on the site. That's a lot of eyes looking out for our community.

Next, answer the two questions intended to make sure this is a good fit for you. The moderators will review each request to join and complete the process. Please respect the guidelines for posting.
