2024 Application Form

One or more scholarships will be awarded to eligible applicants. The amount of the individual awards varies based on the number of applicants and fundraising success of the GCA organization but have generally been between \$500-\$2000. Students who have attended Grapeview School for a minimum of one school year will have special consideration, but all students may apply. Scholarships will be paid directly to the post secondary institution in which the student enrolls. Scholarships are available for students attending public and private universities, colleges, and vocational, technical or trade schools in the United States that are accredited through state educational systems or by industry.
