One or more scholarships will be awarded to eligible applicants. The amount of the individual awards varies based on the number of applicants, as well as the fundraising success of GCA, but amounts have generally been between \$500-\$2000. **Students who have attended Grapeview School for a minimum of one school year will have special consideration, but all students may apply.** Scholarships will be paid directly to the post secondary institution in which the student enrolls. Scholarships are available for students attending public and private universities and colleges, as well as vocational, technical or trade schools in the United States, which are accredited through state education agencies or by industry.

Applications from North Mason High School students are due by the deadline set by the school for scholarship notebooks.
